Dr. Gordon J. Christensen is Founder and Director of **Practical Clinical Courses (PCC)**

and Chief Executive Officer of **Clinicians Report (CR)** in Provo, Utah.

Dr. Christensen has presented over 45,000 hours of continuing education throughout the world and has published many articles and books.

Gordon and Dr. Rella Christensen are co-founders of the non-profit **CLINICIANS REPORT (previously CRA)**, which Rella directed for many years. Since 1976, they have conducted research in all areas of dentistry and published the findings to the profession in the well-known CRA Newsletter now called **CLINICIANS REPORT**.

Gordon's degrees include: DDS, University of Southern California; MSD, University of Washington; PhD, University of Denver; and two honorary doctorates.

Early in his career, Gordon helped initiate the University of Kentucky and University of Colorado dental schools and taught at the University of Washington.

Gordon is a practicing prosthodontist in Provo, Utah. Gordon and Rella's sons are both dentists. William is a prosthodontist, and Michael is a general dentist. Their daughter, Carlene, is a teacher.

Gordon is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics, a Fellow and Diplomate in the International Congress of Oral

Implantologists, a Fellow in the Academy of Osseointegration, American College of Dentists, International College of Dentists, American College of Prosthodontists, Academy of General Dentistry (Hon), Royal College of Surgeons of England, and an Associate Fellow in the American Academy of Implant Dentistry.

Some of his other memberships include: American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry; International Association of Dental Research; Academy of LDS Dentists; American Academy of Restorative Dentistry; American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics; Academy of Operative Dentistry; and International College of Prosthodontists.

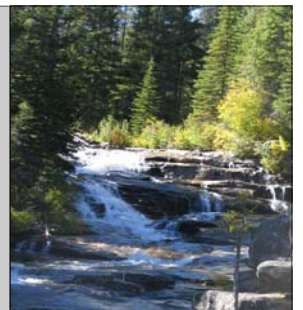

#### **AT RISK!! Your Practice, Your Kids & Your Community**

For the first time in history, automobile accidents are the second leading cause of death by accident in the United States. The Centers for Disease Control announced that in 2009 (the most recent year for which we have statistics): THE LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH BY ACCIDENT WAS DRUG OVERDOSE.

Approximately 3,000 times a month a person presents in an emergency room in the United States dead from drug overdose - usually, young, very often middle class, and almost always by accident, not suicide. Hundreds of people a day present in an emergency room who will live but could have died from drug overdose. Why are they there? When did they start using? Could someone have stopped them? Where did they get the drugs?

Many of these patients never got their drugs from a "dope peddler" in fact; medical and dental professionals were often the inadvertent source of the drugs. In most cases, these patients got their drugs from medicine chests that most often have drugs that have been obtained via prescription from a medical or dental professional. (Dentists write the third highest number of prescriptions for immediate release opioids in the United States.)

Every time a patient dies from a prescription drug overdose, can we all, including medical and dental professionals, look at ourselves in the mirror and say "we tried our best?"

And what about your practice? By the time many companies think about drugs/alcohol in the workplace, they've been blindsided by a lawsuit. They often think they have the problem under control. Unfortunately, they do not realize the costs, not only the measurable ones such as absenteeism, but also completely unexpected accidents that may end up in punitive damage suits, for which they are not insured. Too often, by the time families or companies receive the facts about drugs/alcohol it is part of an explanation about a serious incident and even tragedy. The real tragedy is that this can be prevented.
